



PPWR: Declaration of Conformity

According to Regulation (EU) 2025/40 - Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR)

3. Declaration of Conformity is based on the information provided to us by the manufacturer or distributor of the packaging. The packaging manufacturer is solely responsible for the accuracy of the information provided.

4. The object of the declaration is in conformity with the relevant Union harmonisation legislation:

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 December 2024 on packaging and packaging waste, amending Regulation (EU) 2019/1020 and Directive (EU) 2019/904, and repealing Directive 94/62/EC.

5. Compliance with the requirements of the Regulation (EU) 2025/40

5.1 Absence of Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS)

We confirm and declare that the above-mentioned product is not intentionally manufactured or formulated with PFAS substances and that the product complies with the PFAS restriction thresholds specified in Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

5.2 Restriction of Heavy Metals (100 ppm Cumulative Limit)

We officially confirm that the sum of concentration levels of the following heavy metals:

- Lead (Pb), Cadmium (Cd), Mercury (Hg), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr (VI)) - does not exceed the combined threshold of 100 ppm (0.01% by weight) as required by European packaging waste legislation (PPWR).

Based on the documentation and declarations received from our packaging suppliers and manufacturers, we confirm that the packaging supplied to and/or used by ECP d.o.o. meets the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

ECP d.o.o. acts as a distributor/user of packaging and relies on compliance information and documentation provided by the respective packaging manufacturers and suppliers.

Should there be any relevant change in the composition, manufacturing process, applicable legislation or compliance status of the packaging, the corresponding documentation will be reviewed and updated as necessary.
